2021 MN Fall Expo COVID Plan

The MN fall expo is basing their guidelines off of the CDC and MN department of health. The following has been designed for best safety practices.

OUTDOOR: Current data suggest the risk of transmission of SARS-CoV-2 in outdoor settings is minimal. In general, fully vaccinated people do not need to wear a mask outdoors. Fully vaccinated people might choose to wear a mask in crowded outdoor settings if they or someone in their household is immunocompromised.

INDOOR GARAGE: Fully vaccinated people can still become infected with SARS-CoV-2; however, it may be less severe and the chances of death are less likely. It is still recommended that if you are vaccinated and in a crowded space, to wear a mask. Unvaccinated people should always have a mask on at any point. Hand sanitizer stations will be throughout the garage and available. Maintain space. 6 feet is the safest distance, we understand how hard this can be in this situation so please be mindful of others during this event. Our goal is to make this as safe as possible. Mask up, wash your hands, keep your distance.

INDOOR BUILDING/CLASSROOMS: Masks are 100% required to enter the St. Cloud Public Works facility and any classroom we have. You will be asked to put your mask on, if you do not have a mask, we will have some available. Any participant that refuses to wear a mask inside will be asked to leave.

LUNCH LINE: We all know that this is the biggest crowded space. Masks are required to go through the lunch line. It will be hard (merely impossible) to maintain 6 feet social distance. If you do not have a mask, we will have some available. If you refuse to wear a mask, you will be asked to leave.

EATING: No mask required for eating, once you are done, we ask that you place your mask back on during our announcements. This is because, again, in the lunch area you will not be able to maintain 6 feet.

We appreciate everyone's cooperation during this time. We want to have a safe and healthy event so that we can continue with the Expo during these times.
